



## Western Lake Superior Sanitary District Materials Recovery Center Re-Use Program

WLSSD's Materials Recovery Center (MRC) is a great place for area residents and small businesses to bring their "stuff" for recycling, re-use or disposal!

Oftentimes, unwanted items brought to the MRC are still useful. Quality, reusable items are separated and placed in a special area where other customers can "shop" for free items for their use—reducing the amount of recoverable items sent to landfills.



### Participating in the Re-use program:

#### Dropping off:

- If you believe an item is appropriate for re-use, please be sure to make note of it to the attendant when delivering materials to the MRC.
- The MRC attendant will determine if items delivered to the facility are appropriate for the re-use program. Determination of whether or not an item is appropriate for the re-use program is at the discretion of the MRC attendant.
- Customers are charged a lower rate for items that are diverted for re-use.

#### Picking up:

- The reuse area is available to customers on every Saturday during regular MRC operating hours.
- Customers may examine and select up to two items for their own use at no charge.

#### Other Information

- The reuse area is open for "shopping" on Saturdays only. Items accumulated throughout the remainder of the week will be available to customers on Saturdays.
- Customers may select 2 reusable items per visit, and may visit the re-use area one time each Saturday.
- Safety is very important at the MRC. For the safety of all, children must remain in vehicles and be supervised by an adult.
- Smoking is not permitted.
- Customers may not approach other customers to request their materials for reuse.
- Customers may remove items from the MRC in designated reuse areas only (e.g. tires, scrap wood, re-use area, etc.). Materials may not be removed from any other areas in the facility.
- All re-use area customers must check out with the MRC attendant before leaving the MRC. Customers who have made re-use selections must sign a waiver before leaving the MRC with materials. A new waiver must be signed for each visit. (Waivers are available from MRC staff).
- Business at the MRC should be completed in a timely manner. WLSSD does not allow loitering.
- MRC re-use services are intended to be available to all District residents. The MRC Attendant may deny or limit access to the re-use area if they determine that the frequency of a customer's visits exceeds the intent and purpose of the facility.
- Noncompliance with these rules may result in the revocation of reuse area privileges.
